Backing up the utility is advice and support through the process. In many cases we do the work for our customers, delivering a new merged file.

Merging Territories Non-Tower. This is a utility we use where we are brining in data from other newsagency software packages. With several hundred newsagents switching from other software to Tower this utility has been widely used. This utility imports:

- Customer Names and Addresses
- Customer Orders and Subscriptions
- Customer Balances
- Delivery Fees
- Subagent names and addresses
- Subagent Balances

This utility, too, is run by our experts under the guidance of our newsagent customers, delivering a merged data set ready for business use.

The Expected T2020 Scenario

As the publisher will handle all billing, newsagents in each T2020 area will supply News Limited with a full list of customers and their orders. News will amalgamate these and supply the winning tenderer with a file that contains the customer details:

- Names
- Addresses
- Contact details
- Customer Orders and Subscriptions details to industry data standards.

On a daily basis newsagents will revive a file from News Limited containing delivery changes. For example Stops, Starts, New orders, changed orders. This file will keep systems updated.

The challenge of setting up new runs

The one area of work most likely to require time to setup will be the setup of newspaper home delivery runs. For the most efficient newspaper delivery result, this work is best done manually. We say this based on years of experience. Yes, the process can be automated. However, computers have never driven a car or ridden a scooter throwing newspapers. They don't and can't know what a driver will know about the most efficient approach and the quirks of some customer requirements.
